For the heading 27.10 purposes, the following processes confer the status of originating goods</p> <p>(a) Atmospheric distillation - A separation process in which petroleum is converted in a distillation tower into fractions according to boiling point. Subsequently the vapors are condensed into different liquid fractions; liquefied petroleum gas, naphtha, gasoline, kerosene, diesel (heating oil), light gas oils, and lubricant bases are produced by atmospheric distillation of petroleum;</p> <p>(b) Vacuum distillation - Distillation at a pressure below atmospheric, but not so low as to be considered molecular distillation. Vacuum distillation is used to distill heat-sensitive products with high boiling points, such as heavy distillates contained in petroleum, from which light and heavy vacuum gas oils and residues are obtained. In some refineries, the gas oils can be further processed to obtain bases for lubricating oils;</p> <p>(c) Catalytic hydroprocessing - The cracking and/or treatment of petroleum derivatives with hydrogen at high temperatures and pressure, with the presence of special catalysts.
