

## **Annex II**

### **Schedule of Ecuador**

#### **Explanatory Notes**

1. The Schedule of a Party to this Annex sets out, pursuant to Article 8.6 (Non-Conforming Measures), the specific sectors, sub-sectors, or activities for which that Party may maintain existing, or adopt new or more restrictive, measures that do not conform with obligations imposed by:

- (a) Article 8.2 (National Treatment);
- (b) Article 8.3 (Most-Favored-Nation Treatment);
- (c) Article 8.4 (Market Access); or
- (d) Article 8.5 (Local Presence).

2. Each Schedule entry sets out the following elements:

- (a) **Sector** refers to the sector for which the entry is made;
- (b) **Sub-sector** refers to the specific sector for which the entry is made;
- (c) **Obligations Concerned** specifies the article(s) referred to in paragraph 1 that, pursuant to Article 8.6.2, do not apply to the sectors, sub-sectors, or activities scheduled in the entry;
- (d) **Level of Government** indicates the level of government maintaining the measures, on which a reservation is taken;
- (e) **Description** sets out the scope of the sectors, sub-sectors, or activities covered by the entry; and
- (f) **Existing Measures** identifies, for transparency purposes, existing measures that apply to the sectors, sub-sectors, or activities covered by the entry.

3. In accordance with Article 8.6 (Non-Conforming Measures), the articles of this Agreement specified in the **Obligations Concerned** element of an entry do not apply to the sectors, sub-sectors, and activities identified in the **Description** element of that entry.

4. In the interpretation of a Schedule entry, all elements of the entry shall be considered. The **Description** element shall prevail over the other elements.

Ecuador reserves the right to adopt or maintain any measure that accords differential treatment to countries under any bilateral or multilateral international agreement in force or signed after the date of entry into force of this Agreement in the matter of:

- (a) aviation;
- (b) fishing; and
- (c) maritime matters, including salvage.

For greater certainty, government support programs, through subsidies, for the promotion of cultural activities are not subject to the limitations or obligations of this Agreement.

For the purposes of this entry, “cultural industries” includes persons involved in any of the following activities:

- (a) publication, distribution or sale of books, magazines, periodicals or newspapers in printed or machine-readable form, but not including the sole printing or typesetting activity of any of the foregoing;
- (b) production and presentation of performing arts;
- (c) production and exhibition of visual arts;
- (d) publication, distribution or sale of music in printed or legible form by any means;
- (e) design, production, distribution and sale of handicrafts;

- (f) broadcasting to the general public, as well as all activities related to radio, television and cable transmission, and satellite programming services and transmission network services; and
- (g) creation and design of advertising content.

Ecuador reserves the right to adopt or maintain any measure that is not inconsistent with the Ecuador's obligations under Article XVI of the General Agreement on Trade in Services as set out in the Ecuador's Schedule of Specific Commitments under the GATS (GATS/SC/98, GATS/SC/98/Suppl.1, and GATS/SC/90/Suppl.2).

For purposes of this entry only, Ecuador's Schedule is subject to the following modifications:

- (a) for any sector and sub-sector with regard to which Ecuador's Annex I contains an entry (other than an entry with regard to "All Sectors") that does not list Market Access as one in the Obligations Concerned element, "None" is inscribed in the Market Access column for modes 1 and 2, and "Unbound except as indicated in the Horizontal commitments section" is inscribed for mode 4;
- (b) for any sector and sub-sector with regard to which Ecuador's Annex I contains an entry (other than an entry with regard to "All Sectors") that lists a limitation to the Market Access obligation, that limitation is inscribed in the Market Access column with regard to the appropriate mode of supply; and

- (c) for any sector and sub-sector listed in Appendix II-A, Ecuador's Schedule is modified as indicated in the Appendix II-A.

These modifications shall not affect any limitation relating to subparagraph (f) of paragraph 2 of Article XVI of GATS inscribed in the Market Access column of Ecuador's Schedule.

For greater certainty, an entry of "None" in the Market Access column of Ecuador's Schedule shall not be construed to alter the application of Article 8.5 (Local Presence) as modified by Article 8.6 (Non-Conforming Measures).
