# ANNEX 6-E Schedule of Specific Commitments of Indonesia

## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

- 1) The list of commitments below (hereinafter referred to as "this Schedule of Commitments") indicates the service sectors liberalized pursuant to Article 6.7 and, the market access and national treatment limitations that apply to services and service suppliers of Korea in those sectors. This Schedule of Commitments composed of the following elements:
  - a. the first column indicating the sector or sub-sector in which the commitment is undertaken by Indonesia, and the scope of liberalization to which the reservations apply;
  - b. the second column describing the applicable reservations to Article 6.5 in the sector or subsector indicated in the first column;
  - c. the third column describing the applicable reservations to Article 6.3 in the sector or subsector indicated in the first column; and
  - d. the fourth column describing additional commitments on measures affecting supply of services not subject to scheduling under Articles 6.5 and 6.3.
- 2) The supply of services sectors or sub-sectors covered by this Agreement and not listed in the sectoral column below, according to Article 6.7, is not committed and therefore not subject to any obligation under this Agreement.
- 3) In identifying individual sectors and sub-sectors, CPC means the provisional CPC codes as used in the Provisional Central Product Classification (Statistical Papers Series M No. 77, Department of International Economic and Social Affairs, Statistical Office of the United Nations, New York, 1991). In the absence of specific reference to CPC number, the scope of services sectors/sub-sectors covered by that entries will be subject to relevant and applicable reference, including:
  - a) in the case of Financial Services, reference would be made to GATS Annex on Financial Services;
  - b) in the case of Air Transport, the scope of activities would be in accordance with Article 6.1; or
  - c) Indonesian Standard of Industrial Classification (Klasifikasi Baku Lapangan Usaha Indonesia/KBLI) 2015.
- 4) Double asterisk (\*\*) after a CPC number indicates that the scope of service specified constitutes only a part of the total range of activities covered by the CPC concordance.
- 5) Sectors/sub-sectors marked with "FL" are subject to paragraph 7 of Article 6.7, for measures in both Market Access and National Treatment column or either in the Market Access or National Treatment column. Ratchet (FL) as indicated in the respective column applies to only modes 1, 2 and 3, and does not apply to measures with respect to the supply of service by presence of natural persons (mode 4).
- 6) Sectors/sub-sectors marked with "MFN" are subject to paragraph 1 of Article 6.4, for measures in both Market Access and National Treatment column or either in the Market Access or National Treatment column. MFN as indicated in the respective column applies to only modes 1, 2 and 3, and does not apply to measures with respect to the supply of service by presence of natural persons (mode 4).

- 7) The commitments for the supply of a service by services supplier of another party through presence of that other Party's nationals in the territory of Indonesia in this schedule shall be read together with the commitments on categories of Natural Persons and its respective conditions and limitations for the entry and temporary stay, including length of stay, are as specified in Appendix 6-B-2 and Appendix 6-B-3. In this case, all conditions and limitations specified in Appendix 6-B-2 and Appendix 6-B-3 shall also apply.
- 8) This Schedule of Commitments does not include:
  - a. measures relating to qualification requirements and procedures, technical standards and licensing requirements and procedures when they do not constitute a market access or a national treatment limitation within the meaning of Articles 6.5 and 6.3. Those measures (e.g. need to obtain a license, universal service obligations, need to obtain recognition of qualifications in regulated sectors, need to pass specific examinations, including language examinations), even if not listed, apply in any case to services and services suppliers of the other Party; and
  - b. measures affecting to non-discriminatory requirement of commercial presence within the territory of Indonesia for cross-border supply of services.
- 9) The inscription of sectoral commitments and limitations follows the Guidelines for Scheduling of Specific Commitments (WTO Documents S/L/92, dated 28 March 2001). Measures falling outside of the scope of the Trade in Services Chapter are not subject to scheduling of specific commitments and therefore have not been scheduled.
- 10) Geographical spread means measures in relation to limitations on geographical scope of the commitment which is subject to condition as specified in sectoral section.
- 11) A "none" in the sectoral section must be read as no restrictions or conditions in the specific sector. However, any relevant limitations set out in the horizontal section and general condition if applicable of the schedule will still apply.
- 12) A "none, except" in the sectoral section must be read as combination of the horizontal restrictions and conditions set out in the horizontal section and of the sector-specific restrictions, unless explicitly provided otherwise in the entry.
- 13) "Unbound" must be read as no commitment in the specific sectors with respect to specific obligations.

#### **Definitions:**

"Joint Operation": A joint operation is an undertaking between one or several foreign and Indonesian enterprises of temporary nature, to handle one or several project/businesses without establishing a new statutory body according to Indonesian laws

"Joint Venture Enterprise": A joint venture enterprise is a legal entity organized under Indonesian law and having its domicile in Indonesia, in the form of cooperation between foreign capital and Indonesian (national) capital.

"Contract Management": Contract management is a contract organized under Indonesian law in the form of cooperation on management of temporary nature between Indonesian (national) capital and foreign capital.

"Representative Office": A representative office is an office headed by one or more foreign or Indonesian citizens appointed by foreign enterprise or joint venture company located outside of Indonesia as its representative, with aims to:

- a. Be in charge of the enterprise's business or its affiliated enterprises and/or;
- b. Prepare establishment and expansion of foreign capital investment enterprises, either located in Indonesia and/or in other countries.

- 5. Temporary entry for natural persons engaged in education activities in Indonesia is subject to approval by the Ministry of Education and Cultural. Approval is granted on case-by-case basis.
